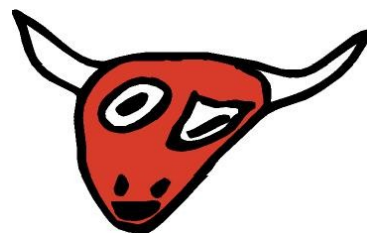


YAK ATTACK 2010 COACH'S LETTER

2/1/10	Registration opens
4/18/10	Registration closes or when tournament fills whichever comes first
4/18/10	Last day for scheduling requests
5/1/10	Last day for team name change. Last day for Team Tweets
5/3/10	Roster sent to T-Shirt vendor. Roster changes after 5/3/10 can still take place but will not be submitted to the vendor
5/5/10	Schedules posted to website
5/7/10	Rosters are frozen. Any roster changes that take place must be done at registration tent at the time of the tournament. All roster changes after this date must provide proof of age and proof of current US Youth Soccer Association (player cards)
5/14—5/15	Registration begins. All players must appear at the Registration tent for a bracelet.
